

Flexi Hose Standards Checklist

EVERY HOME HAS A TICKING TIME BOMB

It's just a matter of time.

BOOM! Ever had this happen?

Flexi water hoses are a ticking time bomb and may eventually fail – with potentially catastrophic results. Most insurance companies will now no longer come to your pool party when this happens.

Braided stainless steel has been found not to provide the required rust protection it first promised. A combination of poor installation practices and chemical attack issues corrodes the braiding over time, leading to the potential bursting of their inner liners.



- Damaged flexible hoses are a major cause of water damage in Australian homes
- Insurance can provide cover, but sentimental items can be destroyed, and homes left unliveable during the repair process
- Check and replace your flexi hoses every 2 years.
